ForestHawk™ 2.0 is designed to help Southern forest landowners maximize their potential while reaching key financial objectives. All property and map data can be combined and stored in one integrated system for total management of the forest. The computer application is a high-tech alternative to time-consuming manual paperwork.

“We want to help forest landowners to become more involved in the management of their assets,” said Rob Morrow, RMS vice president of client services. “With ForestHawk™ 2.0 the landowner is now in control of his forestland.”

Once all your data is in the ForestHawk™ 2.0 system, you can see the entire picture of your property. You can keep stand inventories and harvest and silviculture schedules; create management reports and property maps. Moreover, you can generate real-time changes with the click of your mouse.

ForestHawk™ 2.0 is accessed through the RMS Web site using a 350 MHz or faster personal computer and a user password. As a licensed user, you will receive extensive hands-on training from the RMS staff.

The cost to use ForestHawk™ 2.0 depends upon the current data you have available. In addition, there is a one-time, per acre set-up fee and a monthly user's fee. Subscribers have online access to forestry information 24 hours a day, seven days a week. RMS experts are also available for technical support should you need help. They can even provide management plans to keep your data current. All systems are backed up nightly and tapes are stored in a climate-controlled, fire-safe facility. In addition, an AXNET® Raptor firewall protects your privacy.

Maps

Maps are important management tools for forest landowners. ForestHawk™ 2.0 lets you create, update and print maps with the click of your mouse. When you begin using ForestHawk™ 2.0, RMS will digitize your current property map and save it in the system, which allows you to change or update it. You can split or merge stands and ForestHawk™ 2.0 will automatically recalculate the acres for each new stand and post the changes into your forest management information. You can also add or change other lines on your map such as roads and streams all in real-time. That means maps and forest information will remain in sync in one integrated system.

Another powerful benefit of ForestHawk™ 2.0 is unlimited access to U.S. Geological Survey topographical maps that span the Southeast. This feature allows you to zoom out of your property to see where your land is located on a local basis. You also have the ability to overlay the map to show its relationship to the topography. This feature gives you the information to help you abide by environmental and other governmental regulations.

You can maximize the map feature of ForestHawk™ 2.0 if you provide RMS with aerial photographs of your forestland or allow us to have them taken for you. Once the photos are georeferenced and included in the system, you can overlay your maps onto aerial photos. This allows you to more precisely draw stand lines and other boundaries such as roads and streams. The aerial maps also provide excellent documentation for environmental, operational or recreational challenges you may face.

Reports

ForestHawk™ 2.0 helps you create property reports and compartment stand reports. Property reports will allow you to generate everything from forest attribute reports, forest treatment plan reports and forest history reports covering your entire property. You can even print a property map with report information on it and have all the information you need in a single document. You can also generate reports covering stand details such as wood flow summaries, silviculture and harvest plans.
